COVID-19-Related Agency Expenses

SCPRT has submitted \$113,346.13 in COVID-19-related expenses to FEMA. The remainder of the COVID-19 expenses incurred through June 30, 2020 have been or will be submitted to the Executive Budget Office for reimbursement through the CARES Act funds. The table below contains a categorized listing of all COVID-related expenses to-date. SCPRT anticipates that it will incur approximately \$50,000 - \$75,000 in additional COVID-related expenses between July 1, 2020 and December 31, 2020. The majority of these future expenses will likely be for COVID-related Information Technology/Telecommuting Costs.
