





SOUTH CAROLINA'S CY2023 EXPORT SALES TOP \$37 BILLION

Despite a 2% decrease in total US exports in 2023,

SOUTH CAROLINA'S EXPORT SALES INCREASED BY 18% FROM 2022.

South Carolina exports have grown at an average yearly rate of 4.4% since 2013.

During this same period, the US grew at a 3% rate. The state remains the nation's top exporter of tires and completed passenger vehicles.

#1 CHEMICALS






NAVY BASE INTERMODAL FACILITY PROJECT TIMELINE

2025	NBIF Opens	










SOUTHEAST COMPARISON LOADED TEU GROWTH SINCE 2020
