Re: City of Dillon Appropriated Earmark 2024

Dear Representative Hayes,

The City of Dillon is requesting Appropriated Earmark from the South Carolina State Budget for the following projects;

- \$150,000 to resurface cart paths at the City of Dillon 18-hole Golf Course
- \$100,000 to replace roof on the Proshop and upgrade flooring throughout the Proshop at the Golf Course
- \$100,000 to renovate 18 tee boxes of Golf Course

Total funding for Golf Course = \$350,000

Requested funds for Outdoor Recreation would include the following;

- \$2,000,000 to develop 40 acres of land the City owns located beside and behind the City of Dillon Wellness Center. These 40 acres would include paved walking trails, restrooms, picnic shelters, amphitheater, infrastructure for water, sewer, gas, and electricity, access road, parking, and storm drainage.
- \$750,000 to develop property the City owns in the Downtown area for the Farmers' Market which include covered shelter, parking, fencing, landscaping, event stage, infrastructure, lighting, burial of overhead electric lines.

Total Funding for Outdoor Recreation = \$2,750,000

Requested funds for Downtown Police Headquarters at 101 West Main Street;

- \$700,000 for rehabilitation of 2nd Floor of Historic Downtown Building owned by City of Dillon Police Department. This would include a new roof, electric, plumbing, flooring, HVAC system, life safety measures, new interior walls, exterior windows and elevator.

Total Funding for City of Police Downtown Building = \$700,000

Total request for all projects = \$3,800,000
