FATS VIRTUAL TRAINING SIMULATOR- \$60,000.00

The FATS VIRTUAL TRAINING SIMULATOR is a tool that is being used by Law Enforcement Agencies across the United States. This simulator assists departments across the country in training officers on how to handle many different scenarios. Some of those scenarios include on how to De-escalate a very high stress situation. It will also assist officers with Internal Active Shooter training inside of the department. The simulator is a projector screen that is controlled by an IPAD/Laptop, which the instructor will be able to use to pick various scenarios for officers to train with.

This will be a vital tool to the Bennettville Police Department with assisting officers a more realistic training regarding many different situations that they may face during the course of their job and will help train them with the knowledge on how to handle the many different calls of service they may encounter. The Virtual Simulator that The Bennettville Police Department is currently exploring, is going cost roughly \$60,000.00. That will cover the cost for the projector screen/stand, 2 Firearms (CO2-compressed air), the IPAD/Laptop that supports the software needed.
