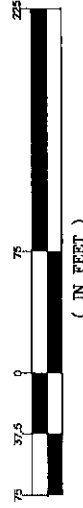

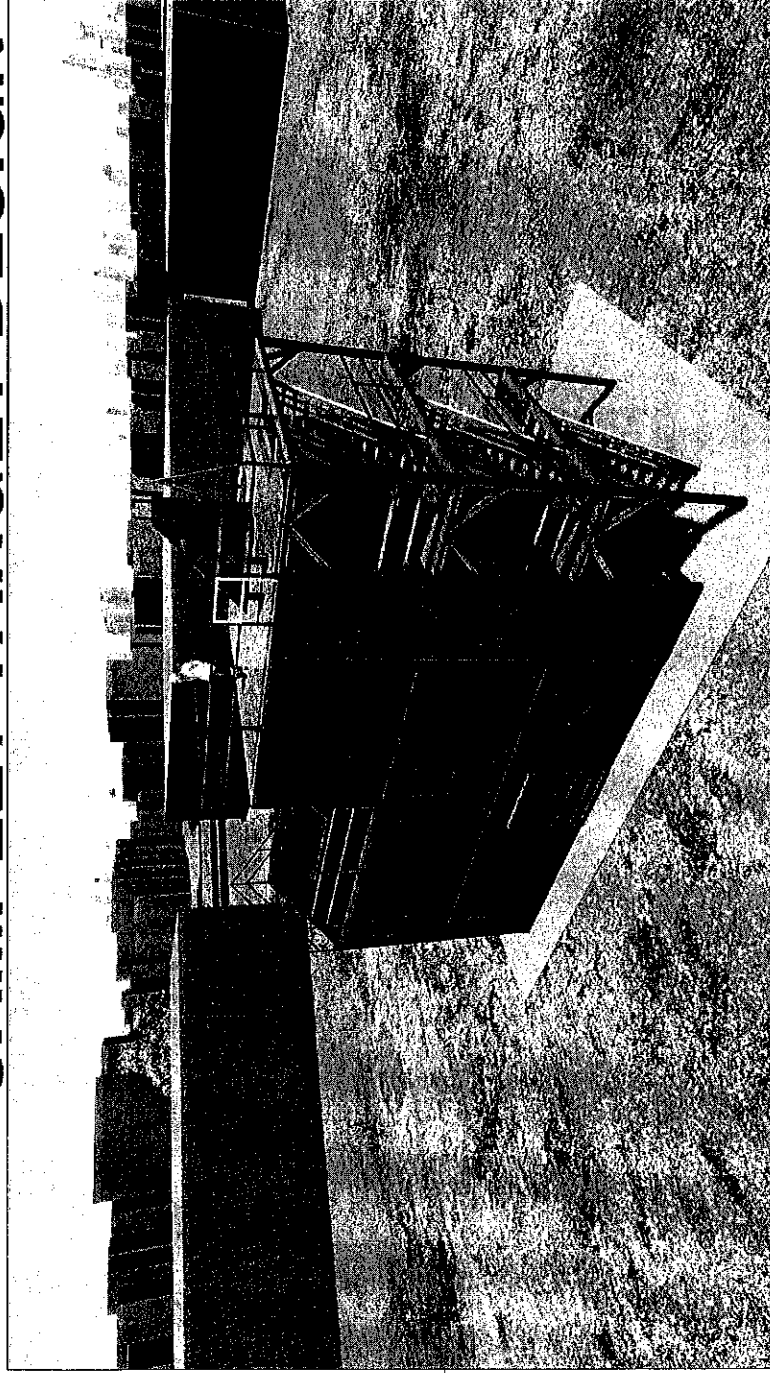
Conceptual Site Plan Fire Substation No. 2 on +/- 3 Acres Greenville County, South Carolina

Hope these projects are still able to be considered:

1. Fire Station #3 - \$5,000,000

Status: Planned, Design Phase

Matching Funds Available: Yes (Greenville County)

- Located at Jones Mill Rd and Scuffletown Rd on 3 acres.
- Will serve northern FI and surrounding fire district.
- Land already acquired for free from school district.
- In early design phase.
- Includes police sub-station (office).
- Would support construction and equipment purchases, reduce response time, and help move department closer to ISO Rating of "1" (highest).

2. Pedestrian Safety & Parking Improvements - \$1,000,000

Status: Shovel Ready

Matching Funds Available: Yes (City [Amt TBD] / GPATS)

- Parking improvements along McKnight Street (Splash Pad parking lot and behind Steam)
- "Woodside Streetscape Project" would increase pedestrian safety and connect downtown to Emanuel Sullivan Sports Complex with wider sidewalks, lighting, and landscaping running from Main Street to Woodside, to the Park.
- Plan has been in the pipeline for a few years, but delays from GPATS / DOT have increased costs dramatically.
- Already fully designed and ready to bid as soon as funding identified.
