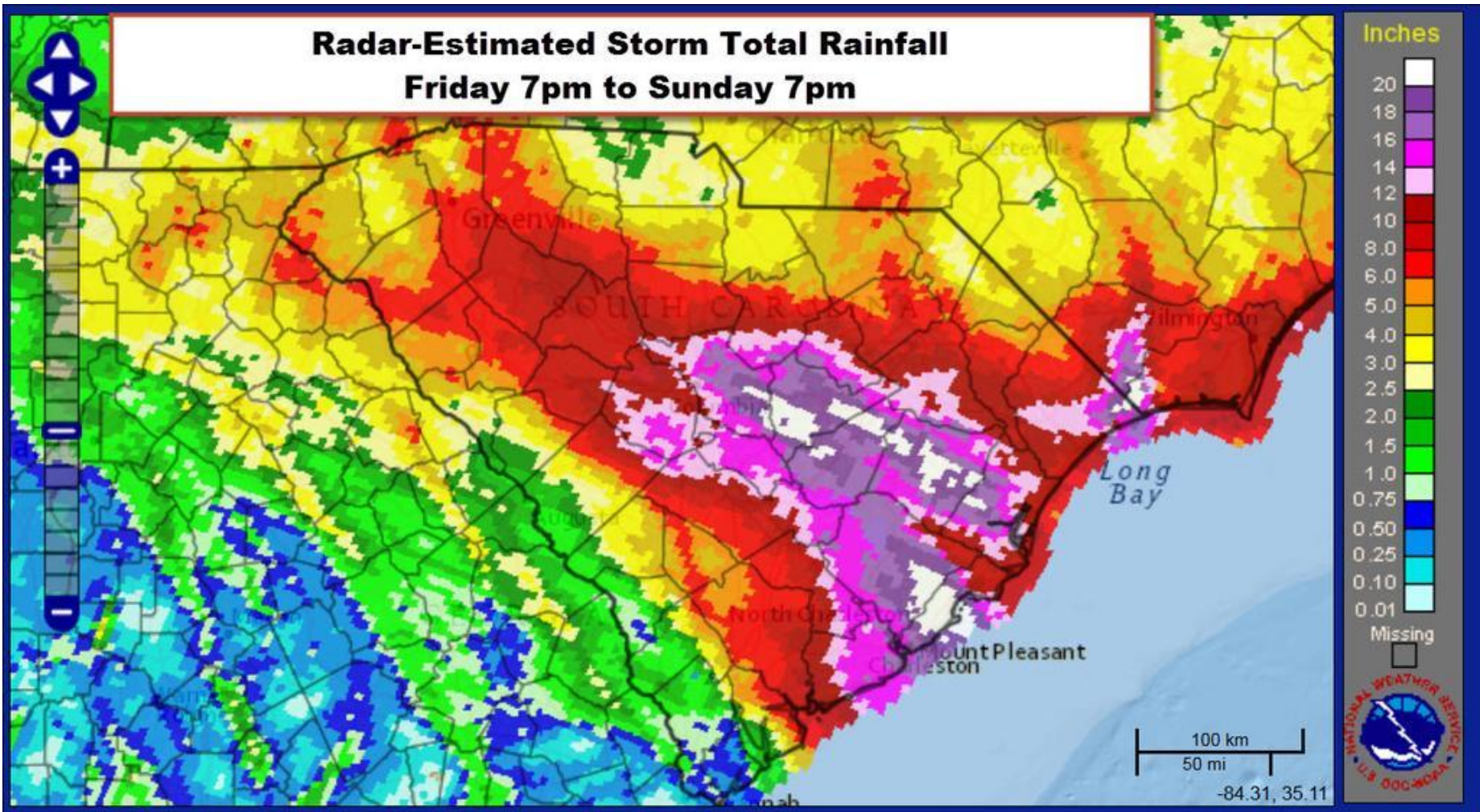

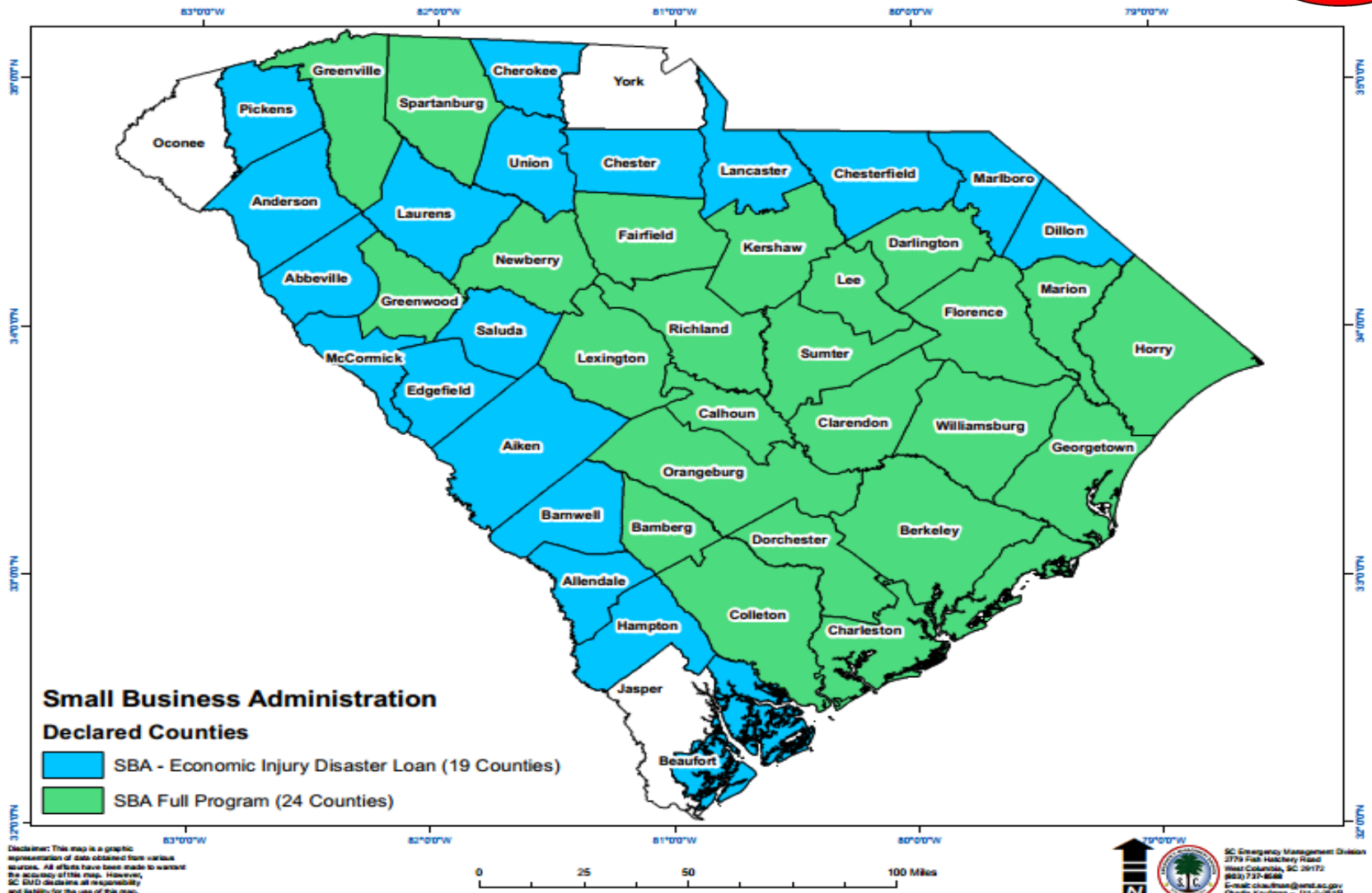
Individual Assistance Declared Counties
