Socially, there have been rare occasions when playing golf with an attorney that a sandwich was eaten at the turn or a drink was had after the round and that particular club does not accept cash or allow charges but requires the member to sign a ticket. On those occasions I attempt to determine the cost and reimburse the attorney.

Regarding lodging, meals and hospitality by an association of attorneys, I have accepted invitations when the entire judiciary has been invited. As an example, the South Carolina Bar Association normally invites the entire judiciary to their Annual Convention and waives the registration fee. I normally attend that convention. Additionally, the South Carolina Association for Justice annually invites the entire judiciary to its convention and waives the registration fee and covers two to three nights of hotel reservations and a banquet. When possible, I normally attend. When I realize that I am not being singled out individually and the entire judiciary is being treated alike, not by an individual attorney or a law firm but the entire association, I do not believe that the Canons of Judicial Ethics are being violated.
