I have never been sued by a client for malpractice. I have been a named party in three civil actions. A pro se Plaintiff, Travis Kemp, filed suit against the elected solicitor, Jerry Peace, and me in my capacity as an assistant solicitor, case number 09-CV-02756, in the United States District Court for the District of South Carolina. I was never served. The suit was "dismissed without prejudice and without issuance and service of process" on December 16, 2009.

The Greenwood County Probate Court appointed me to serve as guardian ad litem for an incapacitated adult in The Matter of Tommy Eugene Henderson (Decedent), case number 2016-ES-24-112. The personal representative of the estate filed a Lis Pendens, case number 2019-LP-24-00006, on January 23, 2019, and I am named as a Defendant in my capacity as the guardian ad litem.

I am a plaintiff in a pending action, case number 2022-CP-01-00208, in Abbeville County. The case involves a dog attack, and my uncle is the primary plaintiff. My pecuniary interest is limited to veterinarian bills.
