I am replacing my former answer with this amended response. In 2005, a defendant, who I had previously prosecuted, named me as a defendant in a 42 U.S.C. § 1983 action. The defendant also named a federal District Court judge, a Drug Enforcement Administration Special Agent, the United States Marshal's Service, Richland County Sheriff's Department and the Kershaw County Sheriff's Department in the action. The civil case name is Daniels v. Currie, et al. The civil case number is 6:04-cv-2280. The case was dismissed without service of process on me or the other named defendants. The case arose out of the arrest and prosecution of the named defendant for several drug related charges. The defendant was found guilty at a jury trial and sentenced. Thereafter, he filed this action.
