It is my privilege to be allowed to amend my answer to Question 32 as follows:

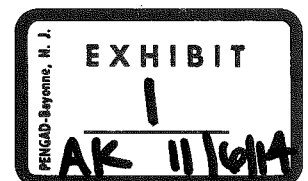
