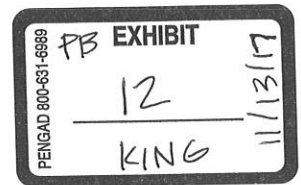

In April 2015 I received some documents in the mail from James (Sheehem) Cabbagestalk, an inmate in Lieber Correctional Institution, Ridgeville, SC, purporting to be a lawsuit or a writ of mandamus. These documents were forwarded to the South Carolina Attorney General. The Assistant Attorney General, Alphonso Simon, Jr. has advised that the action was dismissed by the Fourth Circuit Court of Appeals on July 27, 2015. Transmittal letter to Attorney General, e-mail from Mr. Simon, and Fourth Circuit Court of Appeals documents showing dismissal are attached as **Tab Z**.

I served as a Circuit Vice President of the South Carolina Bar Association, and as Chairman of the House of Delegates, Secretary, Treasurer, and President (1990-1991) of the South Carolina Bar. I received the Order of the Palmetto from the Governor in 2006.
