I am supplementing my PDQ answer #36(b) with the below-listed 3 matters in Richland County.

(1) The matters were: Carnaby Square HOA v. Bessie Moody- Lawrence and Lindberg Moody, Lis Pendens FX118, 2013CP4004661 and 662 (foreclosure for homeowner's dues and Lis Pendens) were filed. As the Personal Representative of the Estate and Payor for my disabled brother, I was named in the matters. I filed an appearance and answer in the matters. The matters were settled and dismissed. This arose out of my informing the opposing attorney on numerous occasions via letter. I had to obtain authority to pay bills on behalf of my brother and the estate.

(2) I had magistrate level matter in Richland County. The matter was: Carnaby Square HOA v. Leah B. Moody, case number 01-4631586. I am not sure the exact cause of action. However, the matter was settled. At that time, I was living in Rock Hill and had a renter in the unit with a property manager. The tenant vacated the property and I did not recover the rent. I paid the outstanding regime fees owed to the HOA."

(3) York County Clerk of Court also had me listed as a defendant in a matter (Dover). I represented the defendant in the matter. This was correct by the York Clerk of Court in 2014.
