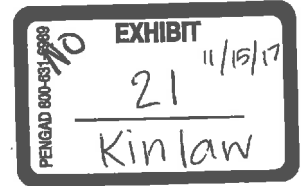

1. Associates Financial Services Com vs. The Estate of Pamela H Fishburne (2000)
 - a) I held a mortgage on the property of Pamela Fishburne which is the reason my name was listed as a party defendant.
2. Timothy A. Reese vs. Alex Kinlaw Jr. (2004)
 - a) Reese Electrical filed suit for electrical work that his company allegedly did that was disputed by me. The matter was eventually settled.
3. Theodore Payne vs. Greenville County – This was a Post-Conviction Relief Action. (2005)
4. Alex Kinlaw, Jr. vs. Riley Young – This was for enforcement of a Bond for Title. (1983)
5. Alex Kinlaw Jr. vs. Denny C. Ellis – This was a Summons for Debt against a client for \$200.00. (2004)
6. Alex Kinlaw, Jr. vs. Linda Hinson – This was for enforcement of a Bond for Title. (1989)
7. Lawyers Cooperative vs. Alex Kinlaw, Jr. – Lawyers Cooperative filed a claim in error against me for books. Case was dismissed by Judge Frank McGowan. (1990)
8. WWW Associates Inc. vs. Alex Kinlaw, Jr. – This was a frivolous action filed in a contract dispute that was dismissed by Judge Frank McGowan on December 27, 1990.
