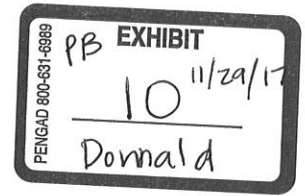

Response:

Since 2003 I have represented numerous clients in Family Court: both as Plaintiff and Defendant involving all types of domestic issues. I have litigated numerous cases involving grounds for divorce and equitable distribution of marital estates. I have litigated dozens of cases wherein my client sought child custody and have defended the same, including establishing child support and seeking to have child support modified. I have represented children seeking support beyond the age of majority. I have represented adoptive parents in both adoptions between private parties and in DSS adoption cases. I have also served as Court appointed guardian ad litem in all the above types of cases. I have attended Family Court Mediator Certification training, and I have served as certified mediator, both successfully and to impasse, on dozens of Domestic cases. For the past five years my Family Court appearances have been limited to serving in my role as program attorney for the Volunteer Guardian ad Litem Program. In this capacity, I have appeared in hundreds of cases including hearing that are brief to multiple day parental termination trials. Since January of 2017, I have also advised and served as program attorney for the South Carolina Vulnerable Adult Guardian Ad Litem program in Sumter and Lee Counties.
