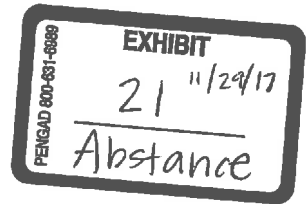
I have never been sued by a client.

I was named as a Defendant in a lawsuit in Federal Court arising from my volunteer service on the Board of Barnwell County First Steps. A former employee filed a lawsuit alleging racial discrimination in connection with the termination of her employment. I disclosed this lawsuit in my original responses. Since I submitted my original Personal Data Questionnaire, I was dismissed as a party and the suit was resolved thereafter. It is my understanding the case was settled at mediation and the action was dismissed. (Ethel T. Faust v. Barnwell County First Steps to School Readiness Partnership, et al. Case No. 1:17-cv-00926-DCN-SVH).

My screening attorney brought to my attention that I was also named as a Defendant in a partition action in which I served as a Special Administrator for an Estate. I had no personal involvement in the subject matter of the action but served as Special Administrator until a Personal Representative was appointed for the estate of the decedent. (Ronny Hair v. Roberta Kirchner, Michelle Abrams Holdorf, and Angela Abstance as Special Administrator of the Estate of Flint Abrams, deceased. Case Number 2003-CP-06-250.) Because I was not personally involved in the suit, I did not recall being named as a Defendant and neglected to include this action on my original response to the questionnaire.
