S 1258 General Bill, By Reese

Summary: Trespassing and unlawful use of property, unmanned, powered model airplanes

A BILL TO AMEND CHAPTER 11, TITLE 16, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO TRESPASS AND UNLAWFUL USE OF PROPERTY OF OTHERS, BY ADDING SECTION 16-11-770 SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT IT IS UNLAWFUL FOR A PERSON TO WILFULLY FLY AN UNMANNED, POWERED MODEL AIRPLANE OR MODEL FLYING MACHINE OF ANY DESCRIPTION OVER THE PRIVATE PROPERTY OF ANOTHER AFTER THE OWNER OF THE PRIVATE PROPERTY HAS FILED A COMPLAINT AGAINST THE PERSON WITH THE SHERIFF OR SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT OF THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE PRIVATE PROPERTY IS LOCATED, AND TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THIS SECTION.
