Summary: Motor vehicle insurance, rental company selling collision coverage not considered insurance agent

A BILL TO AMEND ARTICLE 1, CHAPTER 43 OF TITLE 38, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO PROVISIONS OF LAW GOVERNING THE LICENSING AND REGULATION OF INSURANCE AGENTS, BY ADDING SECTION 38-43-25 SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT A MOTOR VEHICLE RENTAL COMPANY AND ITS AGENTS OR EMPLOYEES MAY, INCIDENTAL TO A RENTAL TRANSACTION, SELL AND COLLECT PREMIUMS FOR OPTIONAL TRAVEL OR MOTOR VEHICLE-RELATED INSURANCE COVERAGES WITHOUT BEING DEEMED "INSURANCE AGENTS", AND PROVIDE THAT THE AGENTS AND EMPLOYEES OF SUCH COMPANY ARE EXEMPT FROM ALL PROVISIONS OF LAW APPLICABLE TO INSURANCE AGENTS.
