A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION TO REQUEST THE MEMBERS OF SOUTH CAROLINA'S CONGRESSIONAL DELEGATION, INCLUDING ALL MEMBERS OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE FROM OUR STATE, TO USE THEIR VERY BEST EFFORTS TO CAUSE TO BE INCLUDED IN THE 2012 FEDERAL BUDGET FUNDING FOR THE U.
