A Bill to amend Section 40-47-600, as amended, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to the requirements for respiratory care practitioners, so as to delete the requirement of good moral character and delete redundant language; and to reauthorize the existence of the South Carolina Respiratory Care Committee for six years.-amended title
