Summary: Incentive offers to attract industry; certain documents used in no longer exempt from disclosure; fiscal impact of incentives required

A BILL TO AMEND THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING SECTION 30-4-55 SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT A PUBLIC BODY OR PERSON OR ENTITY ACTING ON BEHALF OF THE PUBLIC BODY THAT OFFERS CERTAIN INCENTIVES TO ATTRACT A BUSINESS OR INDUSTRY TO INVEST IN SOUTH CAROLINA MUST DISCLOSE THE FISCAL IMPACT OF THE OFFER ON THE PUBLIC BODY OR OTHER GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY AT THE TIME THE OFFER IS ACCEPTED OR REJECTED AND REQUIRE WHAT THE FISCAL IMPACT DISCLOSURE MUST REVEAL; AND TO AMEND SECTION 30-4-40, AS AMENDED, RELATING TO MATTERS EXEMPT FROM DISCLOSURE UNDER THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT CERTAIN MATERIALS SPECIFIED IN IT ARE NOT EXEMPT FROM MANDATORY DISCLOSURE UPON ACCEPTANCE, REJECTION, OR EXPIRATION OF ANY OFFER MADE BY OR ON BEHALF OF ANY PUBLIC BODY.
