Summary: Driving without license

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 56-1-440, AS AMENDED, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO THE PENALTIES ASSOCIATED WITH DRIVING WITHOUT A DRIVER'S LICENSE, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT A PERSON WHO DRIVES A MOTOR VEHICLE WITHOUT A DRIVER'S LICENSE AND WHOSE OPERATION OF THE VEHICLE IS THE PROXIMATE CAUSE OF AN ACCIDENT THAT RESULTS IN THE DEATH OF ANOTHER PERSON IS GUILTY OF A FELONY AND, UPON CONVICTION, MUST BE IMPRISONED FOR NOT MORE THAN TEN YEARS.
