S*1045 (Rat #0339, Act #0305 of 1992) General Bill, By H.S. Stilwell

A Bill to amend Section 23-31-140, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to requirements for purchasing a pistol, so as to provide that the contents of the application include the United States military identification card number for an applicant on active duty in the United States military and that residency is not required of an applicant who is on active duty and who has in his possession a current United States military identification card.-amended title
