S 1082 General Bill, By Thomas

Summary: Inmates, work wages, repayment procedure revised regarding costs required to repay; Prisons and Prisoners

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 24-13-80, AS AMENDED, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO CERTAIN DEDUCTIONS THAT CAN BE MADE FROM MONEY CREDITED TO AN INMATE'S ACCOUNT TO REPAY CERTAIN COSTS INCURRED DURING HIS INCARCERATION, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT THE COSTS INCURRED BY A MUNICIPALITY OR COUNTY FOR AN INMATE'S ELECTIVE MEDICAL TREATMENT MAY BE COLLECTED BY AN ADMINISTRATOR OR DIRECTOR DURING ANY PERIOD OF AN INMATE'S INCARCERATION, TO PROVIDE THAT AN INMATE'S ACCOUNT CAN BE CREDITED TO REPAY CERTAIN COSTS OF ANY OTHER PROGRAMS OR SERVICES THAT ARE VOLUNTARILY OFFERED BY A MUNICIPALITY OR COUNTY TO AN INMATE, AND TO DELETE THE PROVISION THAT REQUIRES THAT ALL SUMS COLLECTED FOR MEDICAL TREATMENT MUST BE REIMBURSED TO THE INMATE IF THE INMATE IS ACQUITTED OR EXONERATED OF ALL CHARGES FOR WHICH HE IS HELD.
