A BILL TO AMEND THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING SECTION 59-18-315 SO AS TO PROVIDE CIRCUMSTANCES AND CONDITIONS FOR A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA IN REGARD TO EXIT AND END-OF-COURSE EXAMINATIONS FOR STUDENTS WHO ARE DEPENDENTS OF MILITARY PERSONNEL ON ACTIVE DUTY STATUS TRANSFERRED TO SOUTH CAROLINA, IF THE STUDENT ENROLLS IN A SCHOOL OF THIS STATE AFTER THE REQUIRED SOUTH CAROLINA EXIT OR END-OF-COURSE EXAMINATIONS HAVE BEEN GIVEN TO THE OTHER STUDENTS IN THE SAME CLASS.
