Summary: EMS personnel eligible for Police Officers Retirement System

A BILL TO AMEND THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING SECTION 9-11-42 SO AS TO ALLOW EMPLOYERS OF CERTIFIED EMERGENCY MEDICAL PERSONNEL FOR PURPOSES OF THE SOUTH CAROLINA RETIREMENT SYSTEM TO BECOME AN EMPLOYER WITH RESPECT TO SUCH PERSONNEL IN THE SOUTH CAROLINA POLICE OFFICERS RETIREMENT SYSTEM, TO DEFINE EMERGENCY MEDICAL PERSONNEL, AND TO PROVIDE THAT THE REQUIREMENTS FOR SUCH MEMBERSHIP AND REQUIREMENTS APPLICABLE FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIANS TO BECOME MEMBERS OF THE SOUTH CAROLINA POLICE OFFICERS RETIREMENT SYSTEM ARE IDENTICAL TO THE REQUIREMENTS APPLICABLE TO EMPLOYERS OF FIREFIGHTERS AND REQUIREMENTS APPLICABLE FOR FIREFIGHTERS TO BECOME MEMBERS, WITH THE APPROPRIATE CHANGES MADE.
