S 1215 General Bill, By Jackson, Glover, Ford and Short

Summary: Breast cancer, insurers may not deny health insurance coverage for persons who have been free of breast cancer for at least five years

A BILL TO AMEND THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING SECTION 38-71-732 SO AS TO PROHIBIT HEALTH INSURANCE ISSUERS FROM DENYING COVERAGE FOR PREEXISTING BREAST CONDITIONS OR FOR INSURED WHO HAVE BEEN FREE OF BREAST CANCER FOR AT LEAST FIVE YEARS.
