Summary: Alcoholic liquor

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 61-6-2010, AS AMENDED, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO TEMPORARY PERMITS TO SELL ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR, BEER, AND WINE FOR ON-PREMISES CONSUMPTION AND BEER AND WINE FOR OFF-PREMISES CONSUMPTION UPON A FAVORABLE REFERENDUM VOTE, SO AS TO REVISE THE ANNUAL FEE FOR A FIFTY-TWO WEEK TEMPORARY PERMIT FOR THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR BY THE DRINK FOR ON-PREMISES CONSUMPTION AND BASE THIS FEE ON THE SEATING CAPACITY OF THE ESTABLISHMENT.
