Summary: Certificate of Need, applicant to post bond when appealing denial of application by DHEC, provisions and exceptions

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 44-7-210, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO CERTIFICATE OF NEED APPLICATION, NOTIFICATION, AND APPEALS PROCEDURES, SO AS TO REQUIRE A CERTIFICATE OF NEED APPLICANT TO POST A BOND WHEN APPEALING THE DENIAL OF THE APPLICATION BY THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROL STAFF IN FAVOR OF A COMPETING APPLICATION OR WHEN A PARTY APPEALS WHO BELIEVES HE HAS BEEN ADVERSELY AFFECTED BY A STAFF DECISION REGARDING A CERTIFICATE OF NEED AND TO PROVIDE THAT NO BOND IS REQUIRED WHEN THERE IS NO COMPETING CERTIFICATE OF NEED APPLICATION INVOLVED IN THE APPEAL.
