Summary: Prison industries

AN ACT TO AMEND THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING SECTIONS 24-1-285 AND 24-1-290 SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE SHALL DEVELOP AND MAINTAIN A MARKETING PLAN TO ATTRACT PRIVATE SECTOR SERVICE BUSINESSES FOR EMPLOYMENT OF INMATES THROUGH THE PRISON INDUSTRIES PROGRAM UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES, TO PROVIDE THAT THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS MAY ENTER INTO CONTRACTS WITH PRIVATE SECTOR ENTITIES THAT ALLOW INMATE LABOR TO BE PROVIDED FOR PRISON INDUSTRY SERVICE WORK THAT INVOLVES EXPORTATION OF CERTAIN PRODUCTS UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES, AND PROVIDE THAT THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS SHALL DEDUCT CERTAIN AMOUNTS FROM THE GROSS EARNINGS OF AN INMATE ENGAGED IN PRISON INDUSTRY SERVICE WORK IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER REQUIRED DEDUCTIONS. - ratified title
