A JOINT RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO SECTION 21, ARTICLE V OF THE CONSTITUTION OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1895, RELATING TO TRIAL BY JURY, SO AS TO PROVIDE FOR ADDITIONAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE JURY AND TO PROVIDE THAT A JURY HAS THE RIGHT TO JUDGE THE LAW AS WELL AS THE FACTS IN CRIMINAL TRIALS AND IN CIVIL ACTIONS IN WHICH THE STATE, COUNTY, OR MUNICIPALITY, OR ANY AGENT OF THE GOVERNMENT IS A PARTY TO THE ACTION.
