H*2732 (Rat #0331, Act #0320 of 1988) General Bill, By Rhoad

A Bill to amend Section 50-11-1020, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to the prohibition against the hunting of raccoons and opossums with any firearm, saw, ax, artificial calling device, or tree-climbing device during any period when they may be hunted without firearms, so as to permit the use of mouth-operated calling devices during field trials.
