H*2912 (Rat #0364, Act #0345 of 1986) General Bill, By House Judiciary

A Bill to amend Section 7-5-120, as amended, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to qualifications for voting, so as to eliminate the requirement that a qualified elector read and write a Section of the State Constitution and to amend Section 7-5-170, as amended, relating to voter registration forms, so as to eliminate references to an applicant reading and writing a section of the State Constitution and to require additional information.
