Summary: Identity Theft Protection Fund

A BILL TO AMEND THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING SECTION 11-11-240 SO AS TO CREATE THE IDENTITY THEFT PROTECTION FUND TO PROVIDE IDENTITY THEFT PROTECTION FOR CERTAIN TAXPAYERS, AND TO PROVIDE THAT THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY SHALL APPROPRIATE AN AMOUNT NECESSARY TO THE FUND FOR THE NEXT FIVE FISCAL YEARS IN THE ANNUAL GENERAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT.
