H 3089 General Bill, By Davenport and Stille

Summary: Bingo, regulation of; repealed upon ratification of constitutional amendment making game unlawful; Gambling

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 11-9-85, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO THE CALCULATION OF REVENUES FROM TAXES AND FEES ON AN ACCRUAL BASIS, SO AS TO REMOVE THE REFERENCE TO BINGO ADMISSIONS; TO AMEND SECTION 12-60-30, AS AMENDED, RELATING TO THE DEFINITIONS OF THE REVENUE PROCEDURES ACT, SO AS TO REMOVE THE REFERENCE TO BINGO LICENSES; TO AMEND SECTION 61-2-180, RELATING TO ORGANIZATIONS LICENSED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE CONDUCTING SPECIAL EVENTS, SO AS TO REMOVE REFERENCES TO BINGO LICENSES; TO REPEAL ARTICLE 24, CHAPTER 21 OF TITLE 12, RELATING TO THE REGULATION OF BINGO GAMES; AND TO MAKE THE ABOVE PROVISIONS CONTINGENT ON THE RATIFICATION OF AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION OF THIS STATE MAKING THE GAME OF BINGO UNLAWFUL.
