**H 3097 General Bill, By J.M. Baxley, P.M. Burch, R.S. Corning, S.G. Manly, Quinn, C.Y. Waites, C.C. Wells, L.S. Whipper and J.B. Wilder**

A Bill to amend Section 15-27-15, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to an interpreter for a deaf person who is a party to a legal proceeding or confined to an institution, so as to establish the position of court interpreter for the deaf and to provide for his functions, duties, and qualifications.
