H 3122 General Bill, By Davenport, Meacham-Richardson, Altman, Clyburn and Simrill

Summary: Sales tax exemptions; certain school supplies and equipment; additional holiday weekend provided for; School Districts

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 12-36-2120, AS AMENDED, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO SALES AND USE TAX EXEMPTIONS, SO AS TO EXEMPT FROM THE TAX SALES OF CLOTHING, CLOTHING ACCESSORIES, FOOTWEAR, SCHOOL SUPPLIES, AND COMPUTERS DURING A PERIOD BEGINNING AT 12:01 A.M. ON THE FRIDAY PRECEDING THE FRIDAY COMMONLY OBSERVED IN THIS STATE AS GOOD FRIDAY AND ENDING AT TWELVE MIDNIGHT THE FOLLOWING SUNDAY, TO PROVIDE EXCEPTIONS, AND TO PROVIDE THAT THE LIST OF THE ARTICLES QUALIFYING FOR THIS EXEMPTION PUBLISHED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE APPLICABLE TO THE AUGUST SALES TAX HOLIDAY SIMILARLY APPLIES TO THE HOLIDAY ALLOWED BY THIS ACT.
