A Bill to amend Section 44-51-60, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to release or retention of involuntary patients being treated for alcoholism or drug addiction and commencement of proceedings for judicial hospitalization, so as to provide for nonemergency hospitalization instead of judicial hospitalization; to require patients to remain in treatment facilities for at least twenty days instead of five days unless discharged; and to provide for release to be postponed for commencement of proceedings for twenty days instead of five days.
