H 3251 Joint Resolution, By Cato, H. Brown, C.D. Chamblee, H.H. Clyborne, Cooper, Hutson, M.F. Jaskwhich, C.V. Marchbanks, Meacham, Robinson, Simrill, D. Smith, Trotter, Vaughn and Young-Brickell

A Joint Resolution proposing an amendment to Article III, of the Constitution of South Carolina, 1895, relating to the Legislative Department by adding Section 15A, so as to require a Bill or Resolution of the General Assembly imposing or increasing a tax or fee must be submitted to a vote of the electors of the State if the Bill or Resolution does not receive the approval of two-thirds of the membership of the House of Representatives and two-thirds of the membership of the Senate.
