**H\*3257 (Rat #0136, Act #0079 of 1991) General Bill, By I.K. Rudnick, J.M. Baxley, R.S. Corning, J.R. Klapman, J. Rama, C.Y. Waites, J.B. Wilder and D.A. Wright**

A Bill to amend the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, by adding Section 39-41-290 so as to require the owner or operator of a motor vehicle fuel service station to dispense gasoline or other motor vehicle fuel to a disabled driver upon his request when he is properly identified by either a placard or disabled license tag and have the gasoline or other fuel dispensed to the disabled driver at the same price otherwise charged for gasoline or other fuel purchased on a self-service basis.-amended title
