**H\*3336 (Rat #0180, Act #0117 of 1989) General Bill, By D.N. Holt, J.J. Bailey, H.M. Hallman, R.A. Kohn, D.E. Martin, Washington and D.E. Winstead**

A Bill to amend Section 5-31-210, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to commissioners of public works, so as to provide that municipalities with commissioners of public works established after 1920 having a population of fifty thousand or less according to the 1980 census may elect two additional commissioners at a special or general election after authorizing them by ordinance.-amended title
