A Bill to amend Act 512 of 1984, as amended, (the Education Improvement Act of 1984), so as to delay by two years, until 1988-89, the requirement for a pupil-teacher ratio of twenty-five to one or less in language arts and mathematics classes in grades seven through twelve in school districts with a student population in excess of nine thousand.
