Summary: Alcoholic liquor and beer and wine permits; childcare facilities included in proximity requirements

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 61-4-520, AS AMENDED, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO APPLICATIONS FOR PERMITS TO MANUFACTURE AND SELL BEER AND WINE, SO AS TO INCLUDE PROXIMITY TO A CHILDCARE FACILITY AS A FACTOR THAT MAY BE CONSIDERED IN DETERMINING IF A LOCATION IS SUITABLE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A PERMIT; AND TO AMEND SECTION 61-6-120, AS AMENDED, RELATING TO THE PROHIBITION AGAINST ISSUING A LICENSE FOR THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS WITHIN A CERTAIN PROXIMITY OF A CHURCH, SCHOOL, OR PLAYGROUND, SO AS TO EXTEND THIS PROHIBITION TO CHILDCARE FACILITIES.
