Summary: All-Terrain Vehicle Safety Act

A BILL TO AMEND THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING CHAPTER 27 TO TITLE 50 SO AS TO ENACT THE ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE SAFETY ACT BY PROVIDING FOR A DEFINITION OF ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES, TO ESTABLISH AN ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE SAFETY EDUCATION AND TRAINING PROGRAM, TO PROVIDE MINIMUM AGE REQUIREMENTS FOR PERSONS WHO OPERATE ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES, TO PROVIDE THAT AN ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE MUST BE EQUIPPED WITH CERTAIN SAFETY FEATURES, TO PROVIDE CERTAIN STANDARDS FOR THE OPERATION AND SALE OF AN ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE, AND TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF ANY PROVISION CONTAINED IN THIS CHAPTER.
