Summary: Plea agreements

A BILL TO AMEND THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING SECTION 17-23-135 SO AS TO ALLOW A DEFENDANT TO ENTER A CONDITIONAL PLEA OF GUILTY OR NO CONTEST OR NOLO CONTENDERE RESERVING CERTAIN RIGHTS OF THE DEFENDANT TO WITHDRAW THE CONDITIONAL PLEA AND TO PROVIDE A PROCEDURE FOR THE ACCEPTANCE OF A CONDITIONAL PLEA AFTER A PLEA AGREEMENT HAS BEEN ACCEPTED WITH THE CONSENT OF THE SOLICITOR OR PROSECUTING ATTORNEY.
