H 3622 General Bill, By Townsend and Wilkins

Summary: Highway work zones, speeding or passing motor vehicle within area where workers present; Transportation, Traffic

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 56-5-1535, AS AMENDED, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO THE PROHIBITION AGAINST SPEEDING IN A HIGHWAY WORK ZONE, PENALTIES FOR A VIOLATION OF THIS PROVISION, AND SIGNS WHICH DESIGNATE A HIGHWAY WORK ZONE, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT THE PENALTIES APPLY TO THE AREA WITHIN A HIGHWAY WORK ZONE WHEN HIGHWAY WORKERS ARE PRESENT; AND TO AMEND SECTION 56-5-1895, RELATING TO THE PROHIBITION AGAINST A VEHICLE OVERTAKING OR PASSING ANOTHER VEHICLE IN A HIGHWAY WORK ZONE AND PENALTIES FOR A VIOLATION OF THIS PROVISION, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT THIS PROVISION APPLIES TO HIGHWAY WORK ZONES WHERE HIGHWAY WORKERS ARE PRESENT.
