H 3643 General Bill, By Law, Merrill, Loftis, Robinson, Rice and Leach

Summary: School building plans, model; series of five presented by architects for use in construction of new; School Districts

A BILL AMEND THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING SECTION 59-23-15 SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION SHALL CAUSE TO HAVE PREPARED BY ARCHITECTS EXPERIENCED IN SCHOOL BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTION A SERIES OF FIVE DIFFERENT MODEL SCHOOL BUILDING PLANS FOR ELEMENTARY, FOR MIDDLE, AND FOR HIGH SCHOOLS, TO PROVIDE THAT THESE PLANS SHALL BE MADE AVAILABLE TO THE SEVERAL SCHOOL DISTRICTS OF THIS STATE FOR THEIR USE WHEN UNDERTAKING NEW SCHOOL BUILDING CONSTRUCTION, AND TO PROVIDE THAT WITH CERTAIN EXCEPTIONS A DISTRICT MUST USE ONE OF THESE FIVE PLANS WHEN UNDERTAKING NEW SCHOOL BUILDING CONSTRUCTION.
