Summary: Deputy sheriff who is an attorney may represent his agency under certain conditions

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 23-15-110, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO A SHERIFF, DEPUTY SHERIFF, OR SHERIFF'S CLERK BEING PROHIBITED FROM PRACTICING LAW OR HOLD THE OFFICE OF CLERK OF COURT, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT A DEPUTY SHERIFF WHO IS AN ATTORNEY MAY ACT AS AN ATTORNEY ON BEHALF OF HIS AGENCY UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES.
