A Bill to amend Section 56-5-6540, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to penalties for and enforcement of violations of the mandatory use of seat belts provision, so as to delete the provision that both requires a violation not to constitute negligence per se or contributory negligence and not be admissible as evidence in a civil action.
