H 3738 General Bill, By Stille and Littlejohn

Summary: Transfer of certain two-year higher education institution

A BILL TO AMEND THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING SECTIONS 59-53-25, 59-53-26, AND 59-53-27 SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT THE UNIVERSITY OF SOUTH CAROLINA LANCASTER CAMPUS, SALKEHATCHIE CAMPUS, UNION CAMPUS, AND SUMTER CAMPUS SHALL BE TRANSFERRED TO THE STATE BOARD FOR COMMUNITY COLLEGES AND TECHNICAL AND COMPREHENSIVE EDUCATION AND ADMINISTERED AS ALL OTHER TWO-YEAR INSTITUTIONS UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF THIS STATE BOARD, TO PROVIDE FOR AN AREA COMMISSION FOR EACH OF THESE INSTITUTIONS, AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE MEMBERSHIP, POWERS, DUTIES, AND FUNCTIONS OF EACH AREA COMMISSION; BY ADDING SECTION 59-53-35 SO AS TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE STATE BOARD FOR TECHNICAL AND COMPREHENSIVE EDUCATION TO THE STATE BOARD FOR COMMUNITY COLLEGES AND TECHNICAL AND COMPREHENSIVE EDUCATION, AND TO PROVIDE FOR TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS TO ACCOMPLISH THE ABOVE TRANSFERS.
