Summary: Burglar alarm system businesses; licensure, training, continuing education courses; Labor, Licensing, and Regulation

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 40-79-230, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO QUALIFICATIONS FOR LICENSURE TO ENGAGE IN AN ALARM SYSTEM BUSINESS, SO AS TO REQUIRE AN APPLICANT TO OBTAIN A CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION OF TRAINING OR COURSE WORK FROM THE NATIONAL TRAINING SCHOOL OR THE NICET; TO AMEND SECTION 40-79-240, RELATING TO LICENSE RENEWAL REQUIREMENTS, SO AS TO REQUIRE TWELVE HOURS OF CONTINUING EDUCATION FOR RENEWAL; AND TO ADD SECTION 40-79-245 SO AS TO REQUIRE CONTINUING EDUCATION COURSES TO BE APPROVED BY THE BOARD.
